

Seminar Overview

Finance has always been a leader in the adoption of new technologies that improve the efficiency and reach of the services it provides. Introducing new and possibly disruptive technologies, however, involves a significant level of risk.

The MFSA has recently introduced the Regulatory Sandbox, an environment within which FinTech operators may test their innovation for a specified period of time within the financial services sectors. The aim is to support sustainable financial innovation, ensure regulatory certainty and promote knowledge sharing.

It is probably fair to say that, in order to continue developing financial services in Malta, cutting edge technology will be of the utmost importance. The Regulatory Sandbox will be a crucial support in this transformation.

The IFSP, with the support and participation of the MFSA, will be holding an online information session designed to introduce practitioners to the new Regulatory Sandbox on Wednesday, 4 November 2020 at 16:00.

Dr. Joseph Ghio is a partner at Fenech & Fenech Advocates, a leading multi-disciplinary Maltese law firm established in 1891, where he co-heads the Financial Services and Aviation Departments. He sits on the Council of the Institute of Financial Services Practitioners and Chairs the Investment Business and Capital Markets Sub-Committee.



Mr. Ian Gusman is an analyst at the Malta Financial Services Authority ('MFSA') within the FinTech and Innovation Function. Together with his colleagues, he focusing on the implementation of the respective six strategic pillars outlined under the MFSA FinTech Strategy.
