Robert Attard is EY Malta's Tax Leader, a tenured senior lecturer at the University of Malta and a member of the European Association of Tax Law Professors. He has argued cases at all levels in Maltese courts, including a suite of highly significant cases related to taxpayer rights in the Constitutional Court, and has submitted arguments in the Grand Chamber Case ECtHR. He is part of the Supervisory Council of the Observatory for Taxpayers' Rights, and in 2021, he was invited to draft EATLP submissions on EU taxpayers' rights to the EU Commission. He formed part of a study group of the International Law Association on the "Protection of Taxpayers' Rights" and is a published author on tax law, publishing articles in *European Taxation*, *EC Tax Review*, *World Tax Journal* and the *British Tax Review*. Robert's most recent publication is "Taxation at the European Court of Human Rights" co-authored with former ECtHR judge Pinto de Albuquerque (Wolters Kluwer Law 2023).
